## News from the Haematology Clinical Research Unit (HCRU)

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2023 is becoming a very productive and exciting year for the Haematology Clinical Research Unit at Concord Hospital, with our expanding team of haematologists and clinical research nurses reflecting the ongoing large number of trials in our portfolio. The unit currently has a total of 55 clinical trials open, of which 28 trials are currently recruiting, and the remainder have patients who are in ongoing follow-up.

### Some standout trials for 2023 have been:

- **COALITION**, an investigator- initiated Australian multicentre trial for young patients with aggressive B cell lymphoma. In this trial, patients with a high-risk form of this lymphoma receive a new standard therapy not yet reimbursed in Australia (polatuzumab-RCHOP) or an investigational combination of a novel bispecific antibody with the standard chemotherapy (glofitamab-RCHP).
- BelaCARD, an investigator-initiated Australian multicentre trial for relapsed multiple myeloma using a novel antibody-drug conjugate combined with standard therapy.

## These trials are part of the Unit's commitment to deliver "World-class care, locally".

At Concord Haematology, we are enabled by the Foundation for A Bloody Great Cause to conduct this independent investigator-initiated research, and we thank our amazing community, patients and families for the support they give the Foundation.

In our next newsletter, we look forward to introducing you to the HCRU's newest staff members.
